- 1. INDIVIDUAL TOURNAMENT: This is an individual tournament. All prize money will be awarded to one individual.
- TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE: The committee will consist of Santa Fe High School tournament reps. 2.
- 3. ELIGIBILITY: All Florida Saltwater Licensed Anglers.
- HEADQUARTERS/DATE: Sea Hag Marina, 322 Riverside Dr., Steinhatchee, FL 32359 September 6, 2024
- ENTRY FEE: \$50 per angler before August 16th and the cost goes to \$60 after that date. Participants MUST register prior to the start of the tournament.
- DEPARTURE & END TIME: Safe light until 3pm. Lines in the water 30 minutes before sunrise. No boat checks. Weigh-in will open at 2pm and close at 3pm. Anglers must return by boat and be in line at the stage with poker chip and fish in
- 7. TACKLE & EQUIPMENT: Artificial lures, live bait may be used. Spearfishing or gigging will not be allowed. All fish must be caught on rod and reel.
- SAFETY & SPORTSMANSHIP: Safe boating and fishing practices must be observed.
- PERMITTED FISHING LOCATIONS: You must start in Steinhatchee, Florida but you are permitted to travel as far a you would like without touching land during tournament hours.
- 10. SCORING: All fish must follow FWC regulations. Heaviest Trout slot fish only 15-19". Calcutta Trout over 19" only, every angler on the boat must buy in. Pays out 50%. Heaviest Redfish - 18-27". Most Spots - the same redfish you weigh for the heaviest category will count for spots, spots must be separated (not touching, to count as 1). Heaviest Legal Fish - anything legal can be weighed in this category except redfish, trout, sharks, and stingrays. Jr. Angler - anything legal will be accepted other than sharks and stingrays.
- TIES: In case of a tie, the winner will be the individual that weighed in the earliest.
